



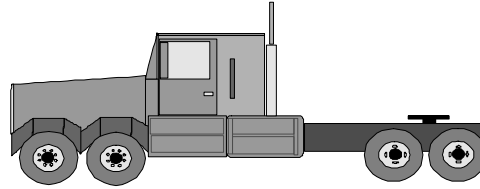
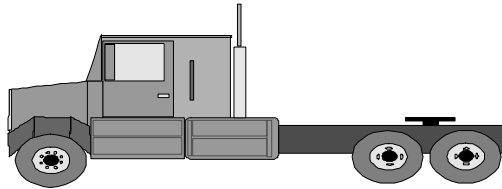

- Load per tire can't exceed 10 kg / mm width
- Permit required to operate
- Fixed Equipment ONLY, not for Tractor unit
- Must have 5.0 m minimum interaxle
- Not valid for travel on Ban Roads
- Vehicle may not tow a trailer
- Weight on steer axle must equalize

NOTE: The steering axle weight allowance is for the tare weight of the truck and mounted equipment only.

A payload or commodity, when loaded on the deck of the truck, must be positioned such that no additional weight is placed on the steering axle

In all cases, the vehicle shall be registered for at least the weight it carries.

* Permitted weights for Permanently Mounted Equipment Only.(eg. Picker, Bed Tk, Pump Tk, Winch Tractor, Coil Tubing Unit, Snubbing Unit, Crane)

** Requests for permit weights above legal weights will require spec. sheet and weigh scale tickets as proof that the extra weight is required.

*** Approvals for annual steer axle permits are normally obtained during Government business hours.
